# **Grammar – complex sentence structures(1)**

## what's great about something is that ...

1. <u>What's great about looking at the sky is that</u> it always can calm my nerves and put me in a positive mood. (sky and stars)

2. <u>What's great about doing sports is that</u> not only it builds up my strength and endurance, but also it's a good way to release my stress. (sports)

## as long as ...

1. No matter where you are, <u>as long as</u> you have a cellphone which is connected to the internet, you can shop online.

2. I believe <u>as long as</u> we do exercise regularly, we are able to stay healthy.

## either ...or...

1. I can finish my homework either today or tomorrow.

2. Either we can meet up for dinner at 6pm or we can take a raincheck.

## neither ...nor...

- 1. <u>Neither him nor</u> me like drinking tea.
- 2. I enjoy <u>neither</u> playing basketball <u>nor</u> football.

## Subjunctive mood

If I were/past tense ... I should/would/could/might +do

- 1. If I were you, I would buy it.
- 2. If I had one more chance, I could make her laugh.

## I wish ... were/had/could done ...

1. <u>I wish I had travelled</u> more in the past since it's not easy to go on a trip freely and safely nowadays. (travelling)

## **Emphatic sentence**

## It is(was) +...+that(who) ...

My father bought me this table last week.
<u>It was *my father* who</u> bought me this table last week.
<u>It was *my table* that</u> my father bought last week.
<u>It was *last week* that</u> my father bought me this table.
